All of the above charges are reduced fees for services performed by a participating general dentist. Fee's subject to change without notice. Consult with your participating dentist prior to beginning any treatment. Fees may not include all lab costs, which would be the member's responsibility. Some services, at the discretion of the general dentist, may need to be referred to a specialist (advanced degree). Payments are subject to change without notification.

*Any treatment provided by a participating specialist, if available, in Oral Surgery, Orthodontics, Periodontics, Pedodontics or Endodontics will be charged at a 25% reduction of participating specialist's fees for that particular case. Some specialists may require a consultation visit before treatment is initiated. Discuss each case with specialist prior to beginning any treatment.

1. Work in progress is not covered.
2. Work in progress after enrollment on the dental plan must be completed before selecting another participating dentist.
3. Any dental procedures performed by a non-participating dentist are not covered.
4. We cannot guarantee the continued participation of any dentist. If he/she leaves the plan, you will need to select another dentist.
5. Not all types of dentists may be available in your area; you may have to travel to receive care from a participating general dentist or specialist.
6. Some providers may charge for missed or broken appointments with no prior notice.
7. Please verify that the dentist is a participating provider when scheduling your appointment.
